He also claims that his sister, without authorization, converted at least four boxes of personal and financial records that he has made a demand for, but claims they have never been returned.

"Defendants intentionally interfered with plaintiff's inheritance expectancy, including by wrongfully using the power of attorney to divert assets from the accounts of Joseph Diak to

defendants own accounts," the complaint states.

Diak is asking the court to order his sister to provide a complete accounting of all funds, assets, investments, and property from September 1999 until the date of his father's death, to impose a lien on misappropriated funds and award damages in excess of \$50,000, plus costs of the suit.
